WHO? Our Mission: Grassroots and volunteer-powered, with your help OFDC empowers women through collaborations with women-focused charities and training; educates children with school sponsorship and the giving of desks to rural schools; and enhances health for all with the funding of water wells and latrines (villagers providing 20% of the costs, your OFDC donation providing the remaining 80%). Our model is mutual collaboration – dedicated, skilled and heart-felt volunteers from both sides of the ocean learning from each other.

WHY? Consider these statistics from the United Nations Development Program:

- 1 out of 3 people in the world lack basic sanitation
- 1 out of 6 people in the world cannot write their own name
- 1 out of 6 people in the world live on less than \$1 a day
- 1 out of 6 people in the world do not have access to clean water
- Every 30 seconds a child in Africa dies from malaria

WHAT/WHERE/WHEN/HOW/HOW MANY? We put your 2016 donations to work in Kenya:

- **Empower Women:** **40** women participating in the Osiligi Women’s microcredit group continued to expand their goat milking project. **2** bicycles were given to women so they can get their vegetables to market in a timely manner, **3** sewing machines were added to the Malawi Women’s Sewing project initiated by OFDC in 2002. **Several** women’s refugee groups in Salt Lake City were provided training for gardening, cooking, and business training. .
- **Educate Children:** **8** girls received assistance in schooling expenses including supplies, fees, and uniforms. **1** student graduated from college, **1** is expected to graduate from college in 2017, and **5** will graduate from secondary school in 2017. **6** schools received improvements which includes **260** school desks for children, the painting of murals and 20 teachers’ cabinets. **Various** small donations were made to children’s organizations.
- **Enhance Health for All:** Over **654** children have better access to clean water at Entaipirri Primary due to OFDC donors funding **1** rain water catchment scheme (parents provide 20% of costs and unskilled labor). **327** children have improved sanitation at Enkaroni Primary schools due to OFDC donors funding **6** latrines (parents provide 20% of costs and unskilled labor).



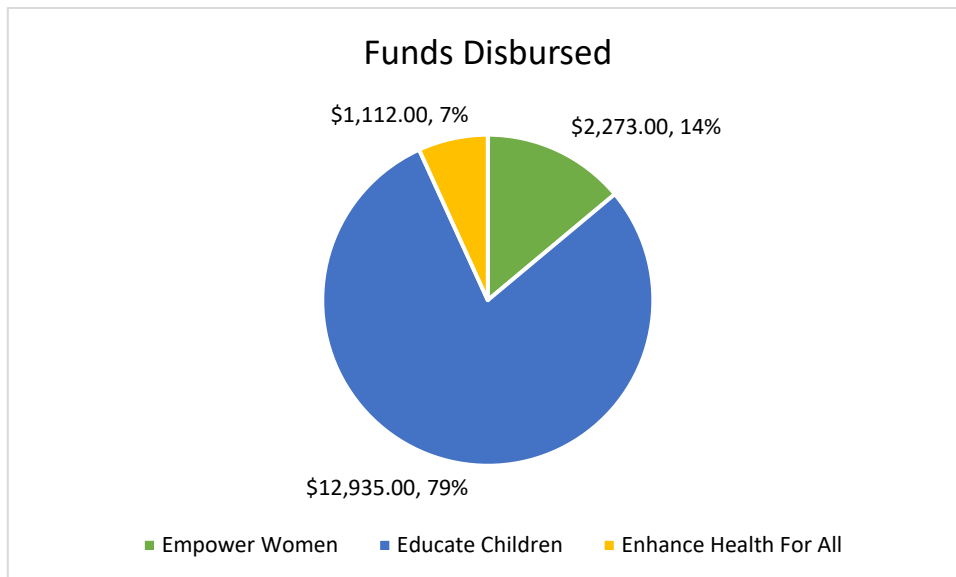
