**WHO? Our Mission:** Grassroots and volunteer-powered, with your help OFDC empowers women with training and Village Savings and Loans (VSL) start-up, educates children with school sponsorship and supplies, and enhances health for all with the distribution of mosquito nets, and funding water wells and latrines. Our model is mutual collaboration – dedicated, skilled and heart-felt volunteers from both sides of the ocean learning from each other.

**WHY? Consider these statistics from the United Nations Development Program:**

- 1 out of 3 people in the world lack basic sanitation
- 1 out of 6 people in the world cannot write their own name
- 1 out of 6 people in the world live on less than \$1 a day
- 1 out of 6 people in the world do not have access to clean water
- Every 30 seconds a child in Africa dies from malaria

**WHAT/WHERE/WHEN/HOW/HOW MANY? We put your 2012 donations to work in Kenya:**

- **Empower Women:** **1,057** women, many of whom are illiterate, attended training in basic health, HIV/AIDS awareness & women's rights under Kenyan law. OFDC donors provided start-up tools, infusion funds and a donkey to **1** VSL women's group. The Ololoiboti Women's group has officers, by-laws and Poverty Alleviating Steps which will help them to move out of poverty. The donkey allows the women to get their wares to market.
- **Educate Children:** **365** scholarships and/or uniforms were given to primary, secondary and technical college students – mostly girls & AIDS orphans. **5** students graduated from secondary school and **1** young lady graduated from teacher's college. **10** schools received improvements which includes **160** school desks.
- **Enhance Health for All:** Over **320** children sleep under nets, provided by OFDC donors, protected from malaria carrying mosquitoes. Over **1,461** children have improved sanitation at their school due to OFDC donors funding **23** latrines (parents provide 20% of costs and unskilled labor). Over **1,610** children have access to clean water from **2** OFDC donor funded wells (parents provide 20% of costs and unskilled labor).

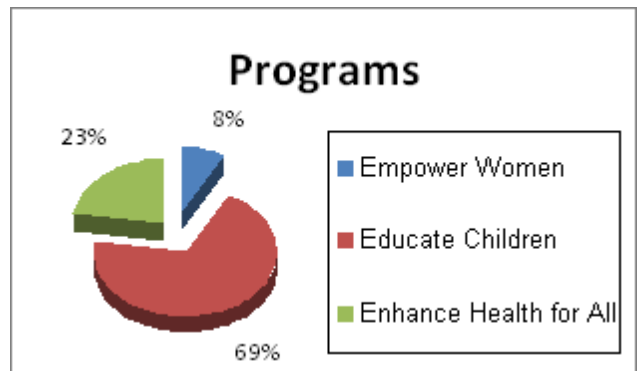
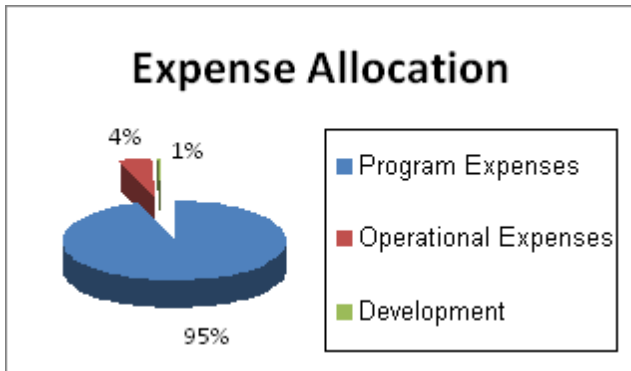
